Within the international dimension of the Erasmus+ Program, the European Union offers grants for staff members for teaching or training purposes in India.

Background and goals	■ Supporting institutional engagement with our partner university
	<ul> <li>Incentivizing further collaborations with our partners with the support of TUM's liaison office in Mumbai (TUM Mumbai) and/or the German House of Innovation and Research in Delhi (DWIH)</li> </ul>
	<ul> <li>Allowing for an exchange of best practices in the fields of student and staff mobility, university management and teaching</li> </ul>
	■ Promoting collaborations on a departmental and faculty level
Funding possibilities and fundable duration of stay	<ul> <li>Staff Mobility for Training (STT): at least 5 days (not including travel days!)*</li> <li>Staff Mobility for Teaching (STA): at least 5 days (not including travel days!)* (At least eight hours of lectures must be held at the partner university per week or part of a week.)</li> <li>Please note that research activities cannot be funded! However a research stay could be combined with a teaching stay (STA).</li> </ul>
	Stay abroad within the timeframe between March 2022 and June 2023
Partner Institutions involved	■ Indian Institute of Technology Bombay
Eligibility	<ul> <li>Administrative and academic staff members of TUM who are in a position of getting an official authorization of business travel</li> </ul>
Support	<ul> <li>180 € per day (from the 15th day 126 € per day)</li> <li>820 € travel expenses</li> </ul>
	Please be aware that the Erasmus+ Program provides no insurance. It is under the staff member's responsibility to insure herself/himself for the whole duration of the stay (medical and liability insurance).
Application and selection process	■ Please submit your application in English to Sarah Huber (huber@zv.tum.de) by July 1st, 2022.
	<ul> <li>The following steps must be taken:</li> <li>Fill out the <u>online application form</u> (after filling, please remember to first print the form before submitting to the portal)</li> </ul>

<sup>\*</sup> The budget available does not allow to fund longer stays than 1, max. 2 weeks, depending on number of applications.

	<ul> <li>Submit the online application to the portal</li> <li>Get all the necessary signatures on the printed application form (sign it by yourself and get the signature of your TUM supervisor/Institute director)</li> </ul>
	<ul> <li>Submit the printed application form and any document which shows that the project is supported by the host university (letter of invitation, email, etc.) via e-mail to Sarah Huber</li> </ul>
	Applications will be assessed by TUM Global & Alumni Office in consultation with the Board of Management and on the basis of the following criteria:
	<ul> <li>Alignment with the goals of this call (see above);</li> </ul>
	<ul> <li>Quality of the project description/ preparation and integration of TUM structures into the project;</li> </ul>
	<ul> <li>Sustainability of the project and added value for TUM.</li> </ul>
	Applicants will be informed in July 2022 about the success of their application.
