

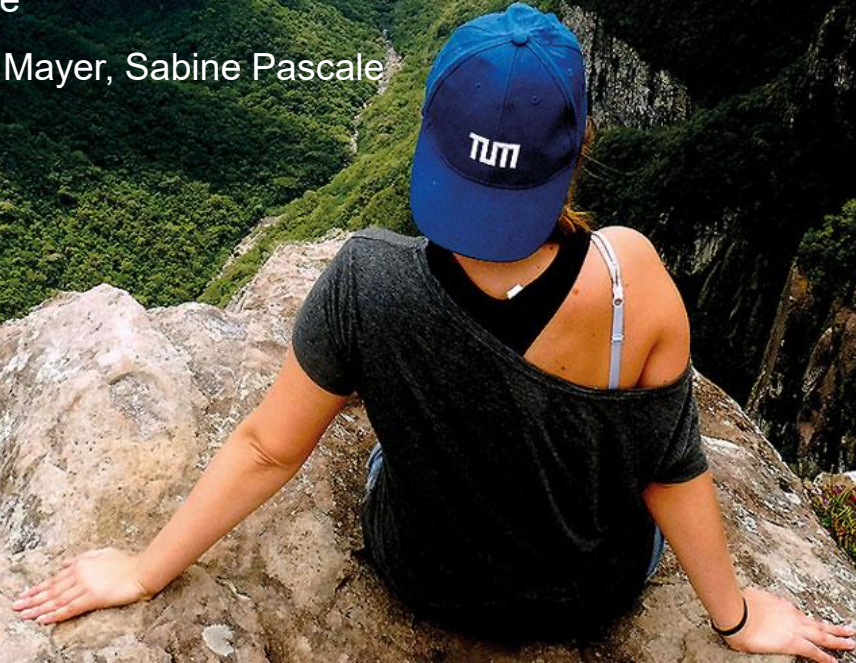

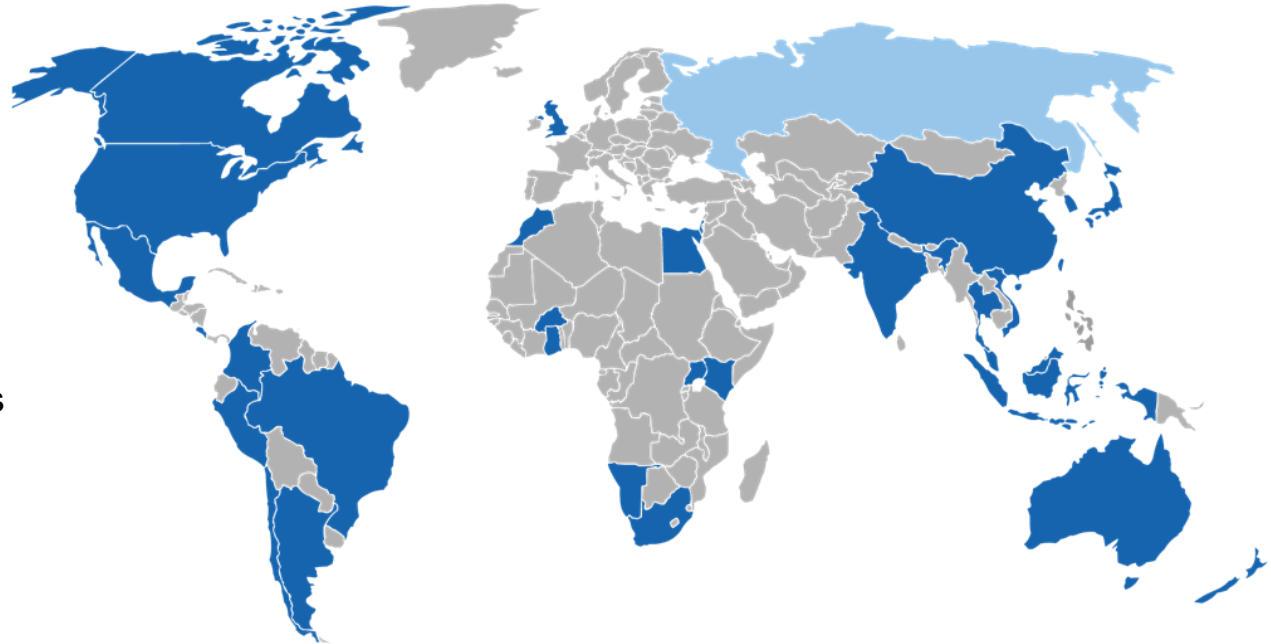

TUMexchange benefits

- **Exemption from tuition fees** at the partner universities
- **Recognition** of study achievements abroad
- **Diploma Supplement entry**
- Training courses on **intercultural communication** at TUM Language Center
- Under certain circumstances a few **scholarships** available

Application requirements

- **Matriculation at TUM** at the moment of application as well as during your whole stay abroad
- **Successful completion of at least four semesters** of your Bachelor studies when starting your exchange semester
- **Sufficient knowledge of the language** of instruction at the partner university
- **Good or very good course achievements.** The required average grade can vary depending on the university's popularity and cannot be determined explicitly

Application procedure

Phase 1: Internal application at TUM Global and Alumni Office (Online)

- Application for a maximum of **two universities**
- Timely submission of **online application**
- **Selection Criteria:**
 - Current average grade of bachelor studies
 - Letter of motivation (academic plan)
- Acceptance/Rejection by TUM G&A **by the end of November 2025 / 2nd round mid-December**

Please note: **Acceptance by TUM G&A ≠ Nomination!**

Application period for a stay in winter term 2026/27 or summer term 2027:

Tuesday, October 21th 2025 from 10:00 a.m. to Tuesday, October 30th 2025 10:00 a.m.

Application procedure

Phase 2: External application at the partner university

- **After the official nomination by TUM G&A Office:** Direct application at the partner university
- Make sure to have the **language proof required** by the partner institution (**student's own responsibility**)
- Acceptance by partner university

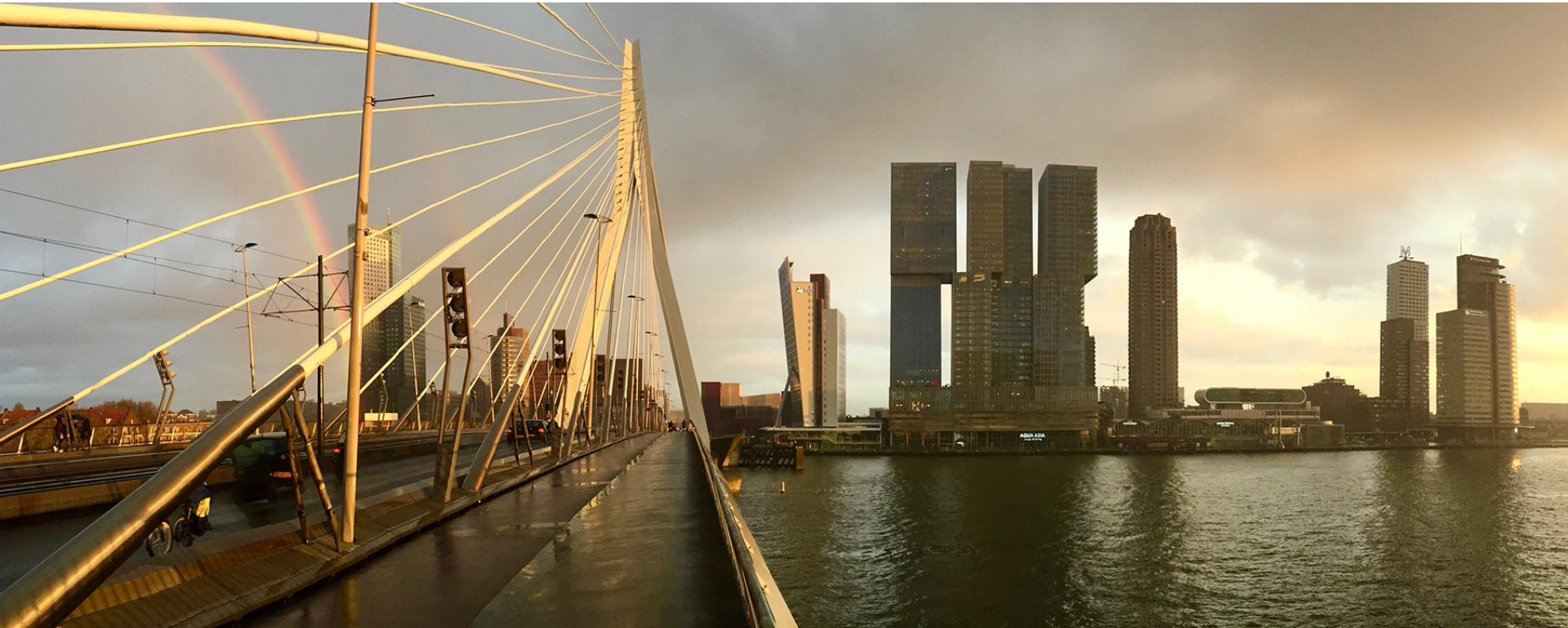
Phase 3: Preparation for the stay abroad

- It is your own responsibility to take care of visa application, up-to-date passport, insurances, flights, accommodation, scholarships etc.

Preparing your TUMexchange application

- **Specific information** about your preferred partner university
- **Experience reports** from former exchange students
- Information about **scholarship options**
- **Download Section** for **Chances** and **Motivation letter template**
- **International Coordinators at your TUM School** (counselling on academic matters)

Internal Application Process



Application documents

- Online Application Form
- Grade report (Leistungsnachweis)
- Motivational Letter (use of our template mandatory)
- CV (no photograph)
- **No submission of Language Certificates!!!**

Grade Report

Bachelor students

- Current transcript of records (Leistungsnachweis) with GPA

Master students

- **Only** Bachelor's degree certificate with GPA and transcript (your Master grades will not be considered)

Medicine students (Considered as master students)

- Hand in "Physikum" (first state examination) with the GPA and transcript

Grades earned outside of Germany

- **Conversion** according to the "**modified Bavarian formula**" (Download section –TUMexchange Website)

Motivational Letter

- **Only ONE document** including both desired universities
- Mandatory to write it **in English**
- Your **academic plan**: Check the course and program offers of your preferred host universities carefully and make sure that it fits your study plan at TUM well.
- Please, be aware that some partner universities allow only to take Bachelor courses, others only Master courses.
- If applying for Universities in **Latin America or Quebec**: Describe how you are planning to achieve the required **Spanish/Portuguese/French** level until the host university's application deadline

Language Certificate only required after official nomination

1.) For the TUMexchange application in October we do NOT need any language certificates

2.) Once the TUMexchange Team has officially nominated you at the partner university:

- Your full responsibility to submit the required language proof at the partner university by the deadline
- Make sure to familiarise yourself already now with the language requirements and the deadlines through the fact sheets and links in our partner university database

Scholarships for TUMexchange



Erasmus+ scholarships

- Eligible partner universities (very limited number of scholarships)
 - **Australia:** University of Queensland (UQ)
 - **China:** Tsinghua Shenzhen International Graduate School (Tsinghua SIGS)
 - **Japan:** University of Tokyo (UTokyo)
 - **Mexico:** Instituto Tecnológico y de Estudios Superiores de Monterrey (ITESM)
 - **Singapore:** National University of Singapore (NUS)
 - **Singapore:** Nanyang Technological University (NTU)
 - **South Africa:** Stellenbosch University (SU)
- Call for the Erasmus+ scholarship will be sent by the scholarships team in spring and autumn 2026
- Individual support: 700€/month of max. 140 days

Scholarship for equity

TUMexchange nominees with a special socio-economic background are eligible for this scholarship

- Call for the Equity scholarship will be sent by the scholarships team in spring and autumn 2026
- Application in spring (for the winter term), in autumn (for the summer term)
- Selection according to personal and socio-economic criteria
- Monthly rate of 400€, possibly with a travel allowance for a stay duration up to 6 months
- Due to the short-notice nature of our funding and budget confirmations, we are only able to provide **final scholarship approvals shortly before the start of the stay**. We therefore kindly ask you to ensure that you have sufficient financial resources available, as we would like to avoid any cancellations caused by potential non-award of a scholarship.

Online Application Form - Registration

- **Register EARLY** on the online application portal and get familiar with the portal and the application form
- Use the **TUM-Account that you usually use for other TUM web applications (i.e. Moodle, etc.)** to register in the portal.
- Please make sure to **keep your login data in a safe place**. You will need it until you finished your semester abroad.
- **Do not** register several times in the online application portal and do not start several applications with different accounts - otherwise your data will not be imported correctly and we cannot process them!

- Do **not upload more than 8 MB** in total, otherwise the PDF file of your application cannot be created.
- You can only send **one application** and cannot change anything after you have sent it.
- **No documents can be handed in after you have sent the application.**
- **We won't accept any applications after the deadline.**

Notification of the application results

- **Please, do not contact us** in order to inquire about your **application status**
- Every applicant will receive an email end of November/beginning of December when the **offers are published in the application portal**
- You have to **log-in into your account**
- If your application was **successful, you will see an offer** and you are **obliged to confirm or reject** the offer within the set **deadline**
- Please, note that **you cannot change the offered semester** anymore
- If your application was **unsuccessful for both of your wishes, you will not see any offer**

Second round of applications

- If you were rejected in the first application round despite submitting a qualified application
- You can apply again for the remaining unfilled spots beginning of December (results mid-December)
- Email at the end of November/Beginning December explaining necessary steps and providing information about the available partner institutions.
- Those of you, who received and rejected an offer in the first round, will not be eligible to participate in the second round.

Next steps

If you got selected for TUMexchange:

- In January we will invite you to join a Moodle-course explaining what to do next

If your application was unsuccessful:

- We strongly encourage you to consider other study abroad programs like Erasmus+ or School programs
