





Eligibility requirements for participation

To participate in the Erasmus+ program and to receive the scholarship, you must meet the following requirements:

- Enrolled at TUM
- Bachelor Students: first year of study successfully completed
- Duration of stay: 60 360 days
- Maximum Erasmus+ participation (study and/or internship): 360 days per study cycle (Bachelor, Master, PhD)
- All required documents submitted completely and on time (before, during and after mobility)
- Minimum of 10 ECTS credits per semester*



^{*}Some departments require earning more ECTS during your stay abroad. Please check specific requirements of your School/Department.



Advantages of the Erasmus+ Program

- No tuition fees at the partner university
- Recognition of your stay abroad according to your Learning Agreement
- Erasmus+ scholarship (funding amount varies from year to year!)


- Students from non-academic households (first-generation academics)

Important: The top-up cannot be combined (if several conditions are met)!

- Exemption of tuition fees at the partner university
- Financial Support for your stay abroad by the Swiss partner university
- Recognition of academic achievements completed abroad
- Application possible after two completed study semesters (Bachelor)

Application period is the same as for Erasmus+ studies 01.12.25 - 13.01.26

Preparation

- Application
 - Early contact with host company (possibly several)
 - Deadlines!
- Finding accommodation
- Specific preparations (depending on country)


Accommodation

- Financed by the host company
- Spain: Many residences
 - Common areas
 - Many students, both international and Spanish
 - Usually more expensive than private housing
- Appartment search
 - Consider costs (warm/cold rent)
 - Location!

Internship at the host company

- Duration: 5 months, 7th april 2025 22nd august 2025
- EF Málaga + 7 weeks Málaga Summer School (MSS)
- Work: mainly in the activities department
 - Planning and organization of events and activities
 - Residence Advisor: point of contact for students
- Unpaid, 35 hours/week
- Overtime compensated with days off
- Languages: Spanish and English (+ German, partly French)





Free time:

- Sports
- Beach
- Tapas
- Evening activities

Costa del Sol: Over 300 days of sun per year





Erasmus+ internship

When is an internship funded by Erasmus?

- Self-organized internship (practice-oriented theses are also eligible for funding)
- **Hosting institutions:** Companies, universities, organizations, single entrepreneurs, NGOs, associations, etc.
- Duration: from a minimum of two to a maximum of twelve months (= 60 to 360 days)
- Maximum salary: 1000€ per month
- Maximum 100 days of funding
- Also possible in the first year of study

Application deadline: 4 weeks before the start of the internship



Erasmus+ Internship in Europe

Graduate internship:

- Enrollment at TUM at the time of application
- Exmatriculation before the start of the internship
- Time of internship: within 360 days of de-registration
- Also possible after finishing your studies





Erasmus+ Internship Worldwide

- Limited number of scholarships
- Allocation on a "first come, first served" basis



Application deadline for internships outside the EU: 8 weeks before the start of the internship
